## **PROJECT PARTNER MEETING IN JŪRMALA (LATVIA), 9-10 JUNE, 2015**

In the framework of the FP7 programme project *BalticFlows* Riga Planning Region was organized project partner meeting held in Jūrmala (Latvia) on 9-10 June, 2015.

The meeting's aims were to develop the Joint action plan with the region's strengths in water technology in the field of urban stormwater management and diffuse load monitoring, activities in citizen participation and the status of smart specialization strategies. The list of project initiatives developed in the framework of BalticFlows project was discussed. Activities regarding on the planned knowledge exchange meetings on *Diffuse pollution in the Baltic Sea Region* in Gdansk (Poland), *Smart specialization in urban storm water management: integrating principles into practise* in Barcelona (Spain) and *Symposium on sustainable approaches to urban stormwater management* in Hamburg (Germany) were planned. The symposium will place emphasis on smart specialization and present case studies of best practises to bring focus to matters concerning stormwater management in Baltic cities and region. Partners reported on status quo of the smart specialization strategies and the regional clusters, contingency plan was discussed after end of the project.
